DRAFTER'S NOTE FROM THE LEGISLATIVE REFERENCE BUREAU

February 22, 2000

To Representative Sykora:

This bill creates, for residential property owners, an immunity from civil and criminal liability and a prohibition on being subjected to an agency proceeding, for the lead poisoning or lead exposure of a person residing in or visiting the property if a certificate of lead–free status or of lead–safe status was in effect at the time of occurrence of the poisoning or exposure. The bill also creates a state residential lead liability fund for issuance of policies providing liability coverage for lead–bearing paint hazards; the policies may be issued <u>only</u> for property for which a certificate of lead–free status is in effect. What would the market be for the policies, given the immunity provisions?
