AN ACT *to renumber and amend* 38.04 (4) (e), 115.28 (11) and 343.61 (6); and *to create* 38.04 (4) (e) 2., 115.28 (11) (b) and 343.61 (6) (b) of the statutes; **relating to:** requiring driver education courses to include instruction pertaining to organ and tissue donation.

#### Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill requires all driver education courses offered by school districts, county children with disabilities education boards, technical college districts and driver schools to include at least 30 minutes of instruction relating to organ and tissue donation and organ and tissue donation procedures.
