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218.32 (3) (i) Fraudulent misrepresentation, circumvention or concealment	
through whatsoever subterfuge or device of any of the material particulars or the	
nature thereof required hereunder to be stated or furnished to the retail buyer.	
SECTION 4. 218.32 (3) (j) of the statutes is repealed.	
SECTION 5. 218.32 (3) (m) of the statutes is repealed.	
SECTION 6. Initial applicability.	
(1) MOTOR VEHICLE AUCTION DEALERS. This act first applies to transactions with	
a motor vehicle auction dealer occurring on the effective date of this subsection.
