

# 1999 SENATE BILL 432

1 AN ACT *to amend* 20.866 (1) (u); *to repeal and recreate* 20.866 (1) (u); and *to*  
 2 *create* 20.395 (2) (fb), 20.395 (2) (fz), 20.395 (6) (af), 20.866 (2) (uwz) and 86.312  
 3 of the statutes; **relating to:** creating a grant program to improve local roads for  
 4 job preservation, granting bonding authority and making appropriations.

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*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

5 SECTION 1. 20.005 (3) (schedule) of the statutes: at the appropriate place, insert  
 6 the following amounts for the purposes indicated:

1           **SECTION 2.** 20.395 (2) (fb) of the statutes is created to read:

2           20.395 **(2)** (fb) *Local roads for job preservation, state funds.* From the general  
3 fund, as a continuing appropriation, the amounts in the schedule for the purpose of  
4 the local roads for job preservation program under s. 86.312.

5           **SECTION 3.** 20.395 (2) (fz) of the statutes is created to read:

6           20.395 **(2)** (fz) *Local roads for job preservation, federal funds.* All moneys  
7 received from the federal government that are credited to this appropriation under  
8 s. 84.03 (2), for the purpose of the local roads for job preservation program under s.  
9 86.312.

10          **SECTION 4.** 20.395 (6) (af) of the statutes is created to read:

11          20.395 **(6)** (af) *Principal repayment and interest, local roads for job*  
12 *preservation, state funds.* From the general fund, a sum sufficient to reimburse s.  
13 20.866 (1) (u) for the payment of principal and interest costs incurred in financing  
14 the local roads for job preservation program under s. 86.312, and to make the  
15 payments determined by the building commission under s. 13.488 (1) (m) that are  
16 attributable to the proceeds of obligations incurred in financing the local roads for  
17 job preservation program under s. 86.312.

18          **SECTION 5.** 20.866 (1) (u) of the statutes, as affected by 1999 Wisconsin Act 9,  
19 section 628, is amended to read:

6 **SECTION 6.** 20.866 (1) (u) of the statutes, as affected by 1999 Wisconsin Act 9,  
7 section 628b, and 1999 Wisconsin Act .... (this act), is repealed and recreated to read:

19 **SECTION 7.** 20.866 (2) (uwz) of the statutes is created to read:

20 20.866 (2) (uwz) *Transportation; local roads for job preservation, state funds.*  
21 From the capital improvement fund, a sum sufficient for the department of  
22 transportation to award grants under s. 86.312. The state may contract public debt  
23 in an amount not to exceed \$10,000,000 for this purpose.

24 **SECTION 8.** 86.312 of the statutes is created to read:

25 **86.312 Local roads for job preservation program. (1)** In this section:

1 (a) “Job” means an employment position providing full-time equivalent  
2 employment. “Job” does not include initial training before an employment position  
3 begins.

4 (b) “Local roads” means streets under the authority of cities or villages, county  
5 trunk highways or town roads.

6 (c) “Political subdivision” means any city, village, town or county.

7 (d) “Population” means the number of inhabitants in the previous year  
8 determined by the department of administration under s. 16.96 (2) for purposes of  
9 revenue sharing distribution.

10 (e) “Project” means the development, construction, repair or improvement of  
11 a local road.

12 **(2)** (a) The department shall administer a local roads for job preservation  
13 program to award grants to political subdivisions for any project that the department  
14 determines is necessary to support business and retain jobs in the vicinity of the local  
15 road. The department may award grants under this section for any costs related to  
16 a project, including costs of acquiring rights-of-way, planning, designing,  
17 engineering and constructing a local road.

18 (b) The department may, upon application, award a grant to any political  
19 subdivision under this section for a project if the secretary determines all of the  
20 following:

21 1. That if the project is not completed, the political subdivision could lose a  
22 number of jobs equal to or greater than 5% of the population of the political  
23 subdivision, or that the project is necessary to retain jobs of one or more employer  
24 who employs at least 5% of the work force residing in the political subdivision.

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1           2. That the political subdivision will provide the local share required under sub.  
2           (3).

3           **(3)** Each political subdivision that receives a grant under this section shall  
4           provide a local contribution toward the costs of the project in an amount equal to at  
5           least 20% of the cost of the project.

6           **(4)** (a) Except as provided in this subsection, grants under this section may be  
7           paid from the appropriations under ss. 20.395 (2) (fb) and (fz) and 20.866 (2) (uwz).  
8           Notwithstanding par. (b), the department may pay from the appropriation under s.  
9           20.866 (2) (uwz) that portion of a grant that is intended to be used to acquire  
10          rights-of-way or to plan, design or engineer a project.

11          (b) 1. Except as provided in subds. 2. and 3., the portion of any grant awarded  
12          under this section for local road construction shall be paid from the appropriation  
13          under s. 20.395 (2) (fz).

14          2. Except as provided in subd. 3., if the portion of any grant awarded under this  
15          section for local road construction exceeds the amount of unencumbered funds under  
16          s. 20.395 (2) (fz), the department shall pay from the appropriation under s. 20.395  
17          (2) (fb) the amount by which that portion exceeds the unencumbered funds available  
18          in the appropriations under s. 20.395 (2) (fz).

19          3. If the portion of any grant awarded under this section for local road  
20          construction exceeds the amount of unencumbered funds under s. 20.395 (2) (fb) and  
21          (fz), the department shall pay from the appropriation under s. 20.866 (2) (uwz) the  
22          amount by which that portion exceeds the unencumbered funds available in the  
23          appropriations under s. 20.395 (2) (fb) and (fz).

24          **(5)** Costs incurred by a city, village, town or county for a project awarded under  
25          this section are not eligible for reimbursement under s. 86.31.
