**SENATE SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,
TO 1999 ASSEMBLY BILL 174**

March 28, 2000 – Offered by COMMITTEE ON JUDICIARY AND CONSUMER AFFAIRS.

1 **AN ACT to repeal** 167.31 (4) (a) 1.; and **to create** 167.31 (1) (em) and 167.31 (4)
2 (am) of the statutes; **relating to:** an exception for peace officers to prohibitions
3 relating to the transportation of firearms in motor vehicles.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

4 **SECTION 1.** 167.31 (1) (em) of the statutes is created to read:
5 167.31 (1) (em) “Peace officer” has the meaning given in s. 939.22 (22).

6 **SECTION 2.** 167.31 (4) (a) 1. of the statutes is repealed.

7 **SECTION 3.** 167.31 (4) (am) of the statutes is created to read:

8 167.31 (4) (am) 1. Subsections (2) (a), (c) and (d) and (3) (a) and (b) do not apply
9 to a peace officer who, in the line of duty, loads or discharges a firearm in, on or from
10 a vehicle, motorboat or aircraft or discharges a firearm from or across a highway or
11 within 50 feet of the center of a roadway.
