

1999 ASSEMBLY BILL 961

1 **AN ACT relating to:** ratification of the agreement negotiated between the state
2 of Wisconsin and the Wisconsin State Employees Union, AFSCME Council 24,
3 and its appropriate affiliated locals, AFL-CIO, for the 1999-01 biennium,
4 covering employes in the blue collar and nonbuilding trades collective
5 bargaining unit, and authorizing an expenditure of funds.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

6 **SECTION 1. Agreement ratified.** The legislature ratifies the tentative
7 agreement negotiated for the 1999-01 biennium between the state of Wisconsin,
8 department of employment relations, and the Wisconsin State Employees Union,
9 AFSCME Council 24, and its appropriate affiliated locals, AFL-CIO, covering
10 employes in the blue collar and nonbuilding trades collective bargaining unit under
11 subchapter V of chapter 111 of the statutes, as approved by the employes of the blue

1 collar and nonbuilding trades collective bargaining unit and approved and
2 recommended by the joint committee on employment relations, and authorizes the
3 necessary expenditure of moneys for implementation from the appropriations made
4 by section 20.865 (1) of the statutes, subject to section 20.865 (intro.) of the statutes.
5 The secretary of employment relations shall file an official copy of the agreement,
6 certified by the cochairpersons of the joint committee on employment relations, with
7 the secretary of state. No formal or informal agreement between the parties which
8 is not a part of the official copy is deemed to be approved by the legislature under this
9 act.

10 **SECTION 2. Effective date.**

11 (1) This act takes effect on the day following publication, except that those
12 provisions specifically identified as having other effective dates in the agreement
13 covering employes in the blue collar and nonbuilding trades collective bargaining
14 unit are effective on the dates provided in that agreement.
