1) FISCAL YEAR INCREASES:

A) General wage adjustment:

Fiscal Year 1999-2000: 2.0% general wage adjustment for eligible employees with at least one year of seniority as of June 30, 1999. A lump sum payment for hours in pay status from July 4, 1999 to the contract effective date.

Fiscal Year 2000-2001: Effective July 2, 2000, 3.0% general wage adjustment for eligible employees with at least one year of seniority as of June 30, 2000. Employees in the following classifications are excluded from this provision: Officer 1-3, State Patrol Trooper, State Patrol Inspector, Police Detective.

Effective October 8, 2000, 0.7% general wage adjustment for eligible employees with at least one year of seniority as of June 30, 2000. Employees in the following classifications are excluded from this provision except employees with a base hourly rate that is equal to or greater than the October 8, 2000 grid end point: Officer 1-3, State Patrol Trooper, State Patrol Inspector, Police Detective.

B) Sworn Law Enforcement Structure: The following classifications are included in this provision: Officer 1-3, State Patrol Trooper, State Patrol Inspector, Police Detective.

Effective June 4, 2000: Employees are placed on the corresponding grid point based on seniority as of January 2, 2000.

Effective July 2, 2000: Employees are placed on the corresponding grid point based on seniority as of June 30, 2000.

Effective July 30, 2000: Employees are placed on the corresponding grid point based on seniority as of July 30, 2000.

Agency budget funds totalling \$125,000 (all funds without fringe, not included in the following) are being allocated to this provision.

Effective October 8, 2000: Employees are placed on the corresponding grid point based on seniority as of July 30, 2000.

2) LENGTH OF SERVICE PAYMENT:

On June 30, 2000 and June 30, 2001, employees shall receive a length of service payment, prorated by FTE, based on the following schedule: 5-9 years = \$50, 10-14 years = \$100, 15-19 years = \$150, 20-24 years = \$200, 25 or more years = \$250.
