Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Assembly Bill 196 would prohibit smoking in buildings on system campuses. In addition, the bill provides that smoking areas may not be designated in buildings on these campuses. Currently, most University of Wisconsin institutions are generally smoke-free environments with smoking allowed in a few areas at each institution.

Institutions would use campus newsletters and similar existing publications to inform staff, faculty, and students of the new no smoking policy. The bill does not require the posting of smoking prohibited signs. The fiscal impact of AB 196 would result largely from the removal of smoking signs in the few smoking designated areas on system campuses. These nominal costs could be absorbed.
