Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

AB23 provides that whenever a bill having an impact on personal privacy is introduced in the legislature, a privacy impact statement must be prepared by one or more state agencies, as directed by DOA, prior to holding any public hearing. The statement would describe the impact upon personal privacy that would result from enactment of the bill and would analyze the desirability of that impact from a public policy standpoint. The bill defines impact on personal privacy based on: 1) the creation of additional personally identifiable information not readily available to the public; 2) creation of an intrusion upon the privacy of an individual; 3) use of the name, picture or likeness of an individual without the consent of the individual; or 4) publicity related to the private life of an individual.

Based on the relatively broad definition of "impact on personal privacy" as stated in the four criteria outlined in the bill, the fiscal impact of AB23 on the UW System is unknown. However, assuming that current UW System staff would be required to analyze only a limited number of bills, AB23 would have minimal fiscal impact on the UW System.
