Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Under current law, a sheriff or other keeper of a county jail may, under emergency circumstances, move jail prisoners to any place of safety. This bill limits the emergency movement of jail prisoners to another county jail or to a building owned or leased by the State of Wisconsin or a political subdivision—and then only with consent of the entity in charge or control of the building.

This bill will not have any fiscal effect on local governments.
