

SUMMARY OF BILL - This bill discontinues the Department's ability to prohibit or require conditions for construction of a bridge over any of the rivers within the state's wild river system for pedestrian, snowmobile, or all-terrain vehicle use--provided that the bridge is limited to snowmobile operators, all-terrain vehicle operators or pedestrians, or any combination of these persons, and the bridge is constructed in whole or in part by a snowmobile or all-terrain vehicle club.
