**Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

This bill would create a nonresident physician license. The Wisconsin medical examining board is required to issue such a license to any person who submits proof that he or she has an unrestricted physician's license in another state and pays the fee set by the bill, which is half the fee otherwise paid by physicians.

The fiscal impact to the agency depends upon the number of physicians seeking such a license. The costs will include printing of applications, postage and processing of licenses. An estimate of 50 applications at \$10 each to print, mail and process would cost approximately \$500.00 and could be absorbed within the agency base.


