Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill supplements the requirement in current law that applicants for hunting or fishing licenses under Chapter 29 of the statutes must provide their social security number. A number of new licenses are created. This bill would expand the statutory requirement that DNR must deny or suspend an application or revoke or suspend an approval if a person fails to provide the number on the new license applications. There is no fiscal impact on the Department as this bill would keep Wisconsin in compliance with existing federal regulations.


Long-Range Fiscal Implications

Wisconsin has until October 1, 2000 to comply with all the requirements of PRWORA. PRWORA, s. 466(A)(13), requires states to collect SSN's on all applications for licenses. Passage of this bill would put Wisconsin in compliance with PRWORA. Enabling legislation was enacted last session, 1997 Wisconsin Act 191 which authorizes the collection of social security numbers on all license applications. This bill would expand that requirement to cover the new licenses created by the bill. The federal government has already threatened states with a loss of federal funding based on failure to comply with a single requirement in PRWORA. Wisconsin faces a loss of close to \$400 million annually if we do not comply with PRWORA requirement. That would eliminate the provision of child support and W-2 services in this state.
