

Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate		
<p>This bill creates a misdemeanor penalty for persons who interfere with the custody of a child from his or her parents or from a single parent for more than three hours beyond the court-approved period of physical placement or visitation.</p> <p>It is impossible to predict the number of new violations that would occur under this provision. Additional new violations may occur in rural areas where divorced parents frequently live far apart and have to drive long distances for visitation. Any additional litigation increases both state and county costs for the extra judge, court reporter, court staff and juror time required to process these new crimes. An accurate estimation of these costs is not possible with the data available.</p>
