Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate Under the bill, beginning in 2001 and ending in 2007, school districts would receive payments from the state to compensate them for any decrease in property tax revenue as a result of the use value assessment of agricultural land in those school districts.		
State Fiscal Effects: According to the Legislative Fiscal Bureau, the state would be required to compensate affected school districts approximately \$9.5 million. This amount would be paid to affected school districts from a newly created appropriation.		
Local Fiscal Effects: The affected school districts would receive approximately \$9.5 million in compensation. This revenue received by a school district would not affect its available revenue limit.
