This bill makes drafting corrections to the Department of Commerce statutes relating to manufactured homes, to correctly include all manufactured homes. The bill makes one reference to motor vehicle statutes. Amendment to S.341.05(26)(a) corrects the references to manufactured home and mobile home to align with the corrected language in Ch 101.
