**Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

This bill will add permit the court to consider an individual' delinquency adjudications in the determination of its sentencing decision for that adult. The effect of this will be to increase the length of sentence given a person convicted of certain serious crimes. The impact of this will be to increase the number of such cases that will go to trial. Increased cases will increase the workload of both the state and county staff of DA offices. Data are not available by which to specifically estimate the number of additional jury trials.


**Long-Range Fiscal Implications**
