Senate Bill 101 requires the Department to distribute to all inactive participants any publications that it periodically distributes to active employes and annuitants. Currently, approximately 100,500 participants are no longer employed in a WRS-covered position, but have left their WRS contributions in the WRS. Of										
those, the Department has valid addresses for approximately 76,000.										
Each year the Department sends three editions of the <i>Trust Fund News</i> to active employes, annuitants and inactive participants who have asked to receive the newsletter and have provided us with a current home address. The number of inactive participants who currently receive the newsletter is approximately 150. If the Department were to send three editions of the <i>Trust Fund News</i> annually to the inactives for whom we have valid addresses, the Department would incur additional printing, paper and mailing costs of \$91,400 annually.										
The cost would increase significantly if the Department had to secure current addresses for the remaining 24,500 inactive participants. For example, locator services cost on an average of \$50 per person, or approximately \$1,225,000. If the Department is successful in locating the current addresses for the 24,500 plus inactive participants for whom we now have no addresses, it will increase the annual cost of sending three editions by approximately \$29,500.
