The fiscal impact to the agency depends upon the number of psychiatrists seeking this status. The costs will include postage and processing of licenses. Postage costs would be about \$250. Staff time to process applications would be about \$160 hours annually at a rate of \$9.721 at the Program Assistant 1 range, about \$1,555. Total increased costs would be \$1805 annually.
