Under current law, the Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection (DATCP) operates two laboratories that provide animal health testing and diagnostic services, one in Madison and one a regional laboratory in the city of Barron.								
This bill transfers the animal health laboratories and their employes to the University of Wisconsin (UW) System on July 1, 2000, and creates a veterinary diagnostic laboratory board (VDLB), attached to the UW System, to oversee the laboratories. The bill authorizes VDLB to set fees for the services provided by the laboratories. The bill prohibits the veterinary diagnostic laboratories from charging fees for diagnostic and testing services conducted for DATCP's Division of Animal Health.
