1999 ASSEMBLY BILL 53

January 21, 1999 – Introduced by Representatives Brandemuehl, Ott, Freese, Goetsch, Steinbrink, Gunderson, Grothman, Hoven, Huebsch, Kreibich, Gronemus, Kedzie, Albers, Ainsworth, Musser, Lassa, Olsen, Owens, Pettis, Powers, Reynolds, Seratti, Suder, Skindrud, Sykora, Spillner and Ward, cosponsored by Senators Schultz, A. Lasee, Fitzgerald and Roessler. Referred to Committee on Agriculture.

AN ACT to amend 77.54 (34); and to create 77.54 (3m) (n) of the statutes; relating to: exempting from the sales tax and the use tax farm animal ear tags and mastitis detection solution.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, various products that are used in farming are exempt from the sales tax and the use tax, such as seeds for planting, animal bedding, fertilizer, medicines used on certain farm livestock and milk house supplies. This bill exempts from the sales tax and the use tax farm animal ear tags and mastitis detection solution.

This bill will be referred to the joint survey committee on tax exemptions for a detailed analysis, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

Under current law, animal identification tags sold by the Wisconsin Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection (DATCP); that agency's sales in FY98 were \$21,550. Sales of insecticide tags are also exempt, since insecticides used in farming are not subject to sales tax. Data on total sales of farm identification tags are not available, so an estimate of the effect of the proposed exemption on state, county and stadium sales taxes cannot be made. Sales of mastitis detection solution, according to DATCP, are not significant, so the effect on state, county and stadium district tax collections is expected to be minimal.
