

Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate <p>This bill allows a court to deny a prisoner's request to bring an action if the prisoner has on three or more other occasions, while a prisoner, sought to bring an action without the payment of a fee because of his or her indigence that was denied because the action was frivolous.</p> <p>It is not known how many prisoner actions would be affected by this provision or the number of actions that would be denied by courts. As a result, any reduction in operating costs for the circuit courts is impossible to predict. Both the state and the county bear the costs for circuit court operations.</p>
