Re: Committee Hearing and Exec

This memo is to notify the members of the Assembly Ways and Means Committee that there will be a public hearing and executive session on 1999 Assembly Joint Resolution 2, on Tuesday January 12<sup>th</sup>, at 9:00am, in the North Hearing Room of the State Capitol. This session will be 2<sup>nd</sup> consideration for AJR 2, which relates to the distribution of the net proceeds of the state lottery and certain moneys received by the state that are attributable to pari-mutuel on-track betting and bingo.

The treatment of this legislation by the Committee is unusual. Typically, I do not schedule a public hearing and executive session for legislation on the same day. Also, the Committee's normal meeting day is Wednesday and the Committee's assigned room is the GAR. However, due to the high priority placed on this legislation by the leadership in both houses, and the desire to include this proposal on the state-wide ballot in April, an exception is being made for AJR 2. I have consulted with Rep. Wood, the Ranking Member of the Committee; he is aware of the high priority of this legislation and the desire by leadership to expedite the process.

An official notice of the hearing and executive session will follow this memo once the legislation is officially referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.
