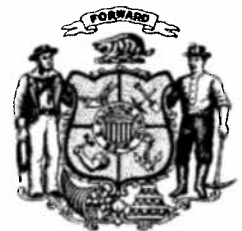

Re: AB 767, Default judgments in municipal court cases

The Wisconsin Alliance of Cities is concerned about AB 767, requiring municipalities under certain circumstances to mail default judgments to defendants.

The bill is before you at the request of the City of Beloit Municipal Judge. Although it may be appropriate and a matter of safety in Beloit to mail default judgments rather than have them personally served, other municipalities are concerned and would like the ability to opt out of the requirement. Therefore we request that this requirement be made optional at the discretion of the court and the municipality.

We want to thank Representative Schooff for working with us on this issue and thank you for considering our request.
