Dear Rep. Plouff:

As you are probably aware, Assembly Bill 517, relating to special distinguishing license plates for veterans of the Laos War, was referred to the Assembly Transportation Committee.

Last session, the Assembly Highways and Transportation Committee approved legislation allowing the Department of Transportation to enumerate special group license plates. Legislators agreed that the approval of new plates should be handled in a nonpartisan manner by the department rather than by the legislature. This legislation was later signed into law and the department is currently in the process of implementing the appropriate rules. Since your legislation would create an exception to the new administrative process, I will not be advancing AB 517.

Although I agree that veterans of the Laos War deserve appropriate recognition, any requests for a special group license plate should be directed to the Department of Transportation. If you have any questions regarding my position on AB 517, please let me know.
