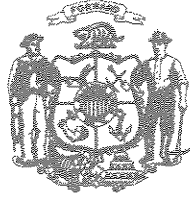

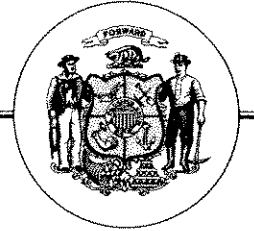

This is a list of last year's (1998) shared utility tax payments for some counties to provide you with a sense of the monetary impact eliminating the payments would have.

Brown County:	\$207,000
Chippewa County:	\$869,000
Columbia County:	\$767,000
LaCrosse County:	\$182,000
Marinette County:	\$167,000
Rock County:	\$252,000
Sheboygan County:	\$495,000

*The county boards in Buffalo, Chippewa, Columbia, Kenosha, Kewaunee, LaCrosse, Manitowoc, Marinette, Rock and Sheboygan Counties have all adopted resolutions in support of this legislation.
