National Forest Income Payment Distribution

Motion:

Move to delete \$1.4 million SEG from the conservation fund for payments to certain school districts with national forest land in their boundaries. Instead, provide \$1.4 million GPR for the same purpose.

Note:

Under the motion, the \$1,805,800 in payments to school districts with national forest land would be fully funded from the general fund. A reduction in the Committee appropriation of \$405,800 would still be made.
