

CLEARINGHOUSE RULE 00-118

Comments

[NOTE: All citations to "Manual" in the comments below are to the Administrative Rules Procedures Manual, prepared by the Revisor of Statutes Bureau and the Legislative Council Staff, dated September 1998.]

2. Form, Style and Placement in Administrative Code

a. In SECTION 1 of the rule, the table is amended to show the new goals for each management unit. Since the rule is establishing new unit 1M, in the left column "1M" should be shown as underscored.

b. In s. NR 10.104 (5) (b) 1., as renumbered and amended by SECTION 2, "sub. (a) subd. 2." should be a reference to subd. 2. of par. (b). Also, the correct format is "subd. 2." [See s. 1.07 (2), Manual.]

c. In s. NR 10.104 (5) (b) 2., as created by SECTION 3 of the rule, "subd. 1." should replace "par. (b) subd. 1." in the first and second sentences. [See s. 1.07 (2), Manual.]

RENUMBERING AND AMENDING, AMENDING, REPEALING AND RECREATING

The Natural Resources Board proposes an order to renumber and amend NR 10.104(5)(b), amend NR 10.104(4)(b), repeal and recreate NR 10.28(1) and create NR 10.104(5)(b)2. pertaining to deer management unit boundaries and population goals.

Statutory authority: ss. 29.014 and 227.11, Stats.

Statutes interpreted: ss. 29.014, 29.177, 29.181, Stats.

In this order:

Section 1. Unit Goals - Establishes new over-winter deer density goals in 30 deer management units.

Sections 2 and 3. Unit Goals - Establishes phased implementation of goals in units 67A, 67B, 70B, 70E and 78 for the next three years, and then permanently.

Section 4. Unit Boundaries - Establishes a new deer management unit map reflecting addition of Metro unit 1M, and the splitting of unit 7 along reservation boundaries.


NR 10.104(4)(b). *Unit goals.* The deer population goals for each deer management unit described in s. NR 10.28 shall be expressed as the number of deer per square mile of deer range in January and are as follows:
