


Good morning Chairperson Robson and members of the committee. Thank you for allowing me to appear this morning to testify. My name is Cindy Benning. I am a pharmacist and the current chairperson of the Controlled Substances Board (CSB), as well as the Pharmacy Examining Board's representative to the CSB. On behalf of both of those boards and the Department of Regulation and Licensing I would like to testify **in favor of Senate Bill 323.**

Since the CSB has been in the Department of Regulation and Licensing, there has been a much greater opportunity to interact with the various health care disciplines that intersect with the CSB. I think the board can do much more, but to do that we need to involve all the players. The lack of inclusion of a nursing and medical representative on the CSB has not allowed us to involve them in statewide trends, or new initiatives nation-wide regarding controlled substances. We would value their input as well as welcome their network to disseminate information to all the nurses and physicians in the state.

As the Controlled Substances Board matures, I think it is imperative that nursing and medicine have a representation on that board.
