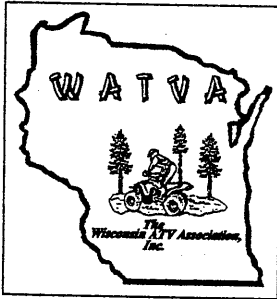

Please know that the Wisconsin ATV Association (WATVA) **DOES** support an increase in weight language that follows our neighboring state of Minnesota statutes (800 pounds). This weight increase will not impose barriers to new technology or make it necessary to continuously revise our own laws.

The type of machine we are speaking of is a "utility" ATV. It's intended use is for work and recreational uses that provide for a smooth, comfortable and stable ride. This additional weight will not be any different than those of our neighboring border states' on which we ride and are just as caring for as our own.
