RE: Clearinghouse Rule 98-159, relating to bicycle helmets and drawstrings in children's clothing; and  
Clearinghouse Rule 99-008, relating to the solicitation of prospective purchasers of burial agreements funded with the proceeds of a life insurance policy.,

On May 5, 1999, the two above-listed proposed rules were referred to the Senate Committee on Judiciary and Consumer Affairs. This memo serves as a written notice of the referral.

Clearinghouse Rule 98-097, relating to bicycle helmets and drawstrings in children's clothing is being promulgated by the Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection.

Clearinghouse Rule 99-008, relating to the solicitation of prospective purchasers of burial agreements funded with the proceeds of a life insurance policy, is being promulgated by the Department of Regulation and Licensing.

The committee has 30 days from the date of referral within which to review each rule. This review period may be extended by certain actions of the committee. Please contact our office if you have any questions or wish to discuss these proposed rules.
