## 1999 ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION

40

1 **Relating to:** the life and public service of Patricia A. Goodrich.

2       Whereas, Patricia A. Goodrich was born on January 13, 1933, in Jefferson City,  
3 Missouri, and died on March 21, 1999, in Gold Canyon, Arizona; and

4       Whereas, she was educated in Missouri public schools and attended Jefferson  
5 City Junior College and Park College in Parkville, Missouri; and

6       Whereas, she married Philo "Bud" Goodrich and raised her family in Wisconsin;  
7 and

8       Whereas, she was first elected to the assembly in 1974, and served as  
9 representative of the 72nd assembly district, including portions of Waushara, Green  
10 Lake and Fond du Lac counties, for 5 terms; and

11       Whereas, she was elected minority caucus secretary in 1979 and 1981; and

12       Whereas, she pursued her interest in educational issues throughout her  
13 legislative career through her service on various assembly education committees and  
14 on legislative council special committees on education and school dropout  
15 prevention; and

1           Whereas, she was appointed by Governor Thompson as secretary of health and  
2 social service in September 1988 and served in that capacity until December 1990;  
3 and

4           Whereas, she served as a project director for studies of children's issues,  
5 especially children living in poverty, on behalf of the Wisconsin council on human  
6 concerns and other organizations which issued a series of reports called "WisKids  
7 Count"; and

8           Whereas, she exhibited an interest in education and the well-being of children  
9 throughout her career; now, therefore, be it

10           ***Resolved by the assembly, the senate concurring, That*** the members of the  
11 Wisconsin legislature commend the devoted public service that Patricia A. Goodrich  
12 gave to this state, express their sorrow at her death and extend condolences to her  
13 family and friends; and, be it further

14           ***Resolved, That*** the assembly chief clerk shall provide copies of this joint  
15 resolution to Mrs. Goodrich's husband, Philo ("Bud"); and her sons Phil, Jim and  
16 John.
