1 AN ACT to create 254.47 (2r) of the statutes; relating to: special event
2 campground permits issued by the department of health and family services.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the department of health and family services (DHFS), or a local health department acting as an agent of DHFS, issues permits to and regulates campgrounds and camping resorts and recreational and educational camps.

Under this bill, a campground permit for a special event issued by DHFS or by a local health department is not valid unless all necessary town or county permits for the special event are obtained as a condition of the necessary town or county permit met. Under the bill, "special event" is defined by DHFS by rule.

For further information see the state and local fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 SECTION 1. 254.47 (2r) of the statutes is created to read: under this subsection
