

1 **Relating to:** the life and public service of Howard B. Eisenberg.

2 Whereas, Howard B. Eisenberg was born on December 9, 1946, in Chicago,
3 Illinois, and died on June 4, 2002, in Milwaukee, Wisconsin; and

4 Whereas, Mr. Eisenberg graduated with a B.A. degree from Northwestern
5 University in 1968, and earned his J.D. degree from the University of
6 Wisconsin-Madison in 1971; and

7 Whereas, he married Phyllis Borenstein on August 25, 1968; and

8 Whereas, he commenced his brilliant legal career by clerking for the late
9 Wisconsin Supreme Court Chief Justice Horace Wilkie from 1971 to 1972; and

10 Whereas, Mr. Eisenberg was appointed state public defender by Governor
11 Patrick Lucey and served in that position from 1972 to 1978; and

12 Whereas, in 1978, he left Wisconsin to join the National Legal Aid and Defender
13 Association in Washington, D.C., and served as its executive director from 1979 to
14 1983; and

1 Whereas, in 1983, Mr. Eisenberg became professor and director of clinical
2 education at the Southern Illinois University School of Law in Carbondale, Illinois,
3 and served until 1991; and

4 Whereas, in 1991, he became dean and professor of law at the University of
5 Arkansas at Little Rock and served until 1995; and

6 Whereas, over the years, he argued more than 300 appellate cases before state
7 and federal courts, including 2 cases before the U.S. Supreme Court; and

8 Whereas, in 1995, he was named dean of the Marquette University Law School
9 and was the first non-Catholic to serve in that position, which he held until his
10 untimely death; and

11 Whereas, his philosophy was to always be available to others, and to be ready
12 to help, especially those who were unable to help themselves; and

13 Whereas, during his tenure at Marquette University, Mr. Eisenberg was called
14 on time and again to help deal with a problem or challenge that extended far beyond
15 the boundaries of the Marquette University campus; and

16 Whereas, he was widely hailed for his integrity and ability to see all sides of an
17 issue; and

18 Whereas, Mr. Eisenberg will forever be remembered for his brilliant mind and
19 compassionate heart; now, therefore, be it

20 ~~Resolved by the assembly, the senate concurring,~~ *That* the members of the
21 Wisconsin legislature commend the devoted public service that Howard B. Eisenberg
22 gave to this state, express their sorrow at his death, and extend their condolences to
23 his family and friends; and, be it further
