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

**2001-03 Statutory Language Request****To: Steve Milller, LRB****From: Robert Blaine, DOA (7-7980)*****Draft Title: Funding for Community Programs***

Agency Affected: Department of Health and Family Services (435)

Purpose: The purpose of this draft is to reduce GPR funding for Community Integration Programs and to replace those GPR reductions with SEG funds from the Medical Assistance Trust Fund. The GPR appropriation under s. 20.435 (4)(b) should be reduced by \$50,000,000 in the 2001-02 fiscal year. The SEG appropriation under s. 20.435 (4)(w) should correspondingly be *increased* by \$50,000,000 in fiscal year 2001-02.

Statutory Citations: Section 20.005 with respect to the appropriations under s. 20.435 (4)(b) and (w).

**MEDICAL ASSISTANCE**

Under current federal and state law, medical assistance (MA) is a federal-state, jointly funded program that provides reimbursement for health care services provided to MA recipients, who have few assets and low income.

Under current state law, three community integration programs provide funding, under waivers of federal MA laws, for home and community-based services for MA eligible persons. These persons are relocated from the state centers for the developmentally disabled or other institutions or facilities, <sup>and</sup> meet level of care requirements for MA reimbursement in a skilled nursing or intermediate care facility or <sup>an</sup> intermediate care facility for the mentally retarded. The funding for services provided under the community integration programs is general purpose revenue and moneys from the MA trust fund.

This bill increases funding for the community integration programs from the MA trust fund by \$50,000,000 in fiscal year 2001-02 and decreases general purpose revenue funding for the programs by \$50,000,000 in fiscal year 2001-02.
