Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill requires the secretary of administration to determine the number of positions in each state agency that were not funded as a result of any reduction in state agency operations appropriations under 2001 Wisconsin Act 16 for the 2001-03 fiscal biennium and any reduction in such appropriations required under this act. Under the bill, the secretary must notify JCF in writing of the determination. If the cochairpersons of JCF do not notify the secretary within 14 working days that the committee has scheduled a meeting to review the determination, the secretary must reduce each state agency's authorized positions for the 2002-03 fiscal year by the number of unfunded positions for that state agency. If, within 14 working days, the chairpersons of JCF notify the secretary that JCF has scheduled a meeting to review the determination, the secretary may make the reductions in the authorized positions only upon approval of JCF.

For further information see the *state* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.
