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

In the memo yesterday from rep. Black, drafting instructions for deleting communication officers and Legislative liaisons was not included.

Following are the instructions for incorporating elimination of these positions in our super amendment to the GOP simple amendment.

Delete the 19 positions identified as legislative liaisons, communications officers or public relations officers in the Leg Council's publication "State Agency Staff Members With Responsibilities related to the Legislature - 2001 Session" from the following agencies: ~~DOA, DATCP, Commerce, Corrections Courts, Educational Communications Board, Employment Relations, DHFS, Insurance, Investment Board, Justice, DNR (2), Public Defender, DQR, Transportation (2) Veterans Affairs, DWD.~~

I am sending over a copy of the LFB paper relating to this topic. This paper identifies the agencies and number of positions and cost savings. Please delete 19 positions, but leave the 3 positions in the UW System.

SUBJECT: Response to Budget Questions

Following is a response to a question you that you asked of this office relative to the estimated costs and number of FTEs in state agencies that serve as "legislative liaisons, communications officers or public relations officers".

There is no ready list that specifically identifies such positions and positions performing these same functions in different agencies often have different position titles. To provide the information you requested, we reviewed the Legislative Council's publication "State Agency Staff Members With Responsibilities Related to the Legislature – 2001 Session" and ascertained from that publication the number of positions listed that were identified as legislative liaisons, communications or public information officers, or public affairs or public relations officers. The following agencies were shown in that document as having one or more such positions: Administration; Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection; Commerce; Corrections; Courts; Educational Communications Board; Employment Relations; Health and Family Services; Insurance; Investment Board; Justice; Natural Resources(2); Public Defender; Revenue; Transportation(2); Veterans Affairs; Workforce Development; and University of Wisconsin System(3). We then estimated an average salary and fringe benefit cost for these 22 positions; that total annual salary and fringe benefits cost was \$1,768,800. Some of these positions would be funded from other than GPR sources. However, if your intent is to eliminate the positions and have the resultant savings accrue to the general fund, the change could be drafted so that that total savings amount would go to the general fund in 2002-03.
