In addition to deleting the reference to transfer of the moneys at page 1, line 6, we will also need to delete references to transfer at page 2, lines 2 and 3. The first full sentence on page 2 of the draft will then read:

"In identifying appropriated moneys *to fund activities conducted under section 254.916 of the statutes* as described in this subsection, the department may not identify any appropriated moneys *to fund those activities if funding those activities* would change legislative intent . . ."


