# 2001 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION

1 **Relating to:** recognizing February 6 as Ronald Reagan Day. ✓

2 Whereas, President Ronald Wilson Reagan, a man of humble background,  
3 worked throughout his life serving freedom and advancing the public good, <sup>by his</sup> ~~having~~  
4 <sup>employment</sup> ~~been employed~~ as an entertainer, union leader, corporate spokesman, Governor of  
5 California, and President of the United States; and

6 Whereas, Ronald Reagan served with honor and distinction for <sup>2</sup> ~~two~~ terms as the  
7 40th President of the United States of America; the <sup>2nd</sup> ~~second~~ of which he earned the  
8 confidence of <sup>three-fifths</sup> ~~25~~ of the electorate and was victorious in 49 of the 50 states in the  
9 general election, <sup>which is</sup> a record unsurpassed in the history of American presidential  
10 elections; and

11 Whereas, in 1981, when Ronald Reagan was inaugurated President, he faced  
12 numerous challenges including inflation and high unemployment <sup>rates</sup> and

13 Whereas, during Mr. Reagan's presidency, he worked in a bipartisan manner to  
14 enact his bold agenda of restoring accountability and common sense to government,

1 which led to an unprecedented economic expansion and opportunity for millions of

8 of the Cold War and the end of the Soviet Union, restoring democracy to a region long
