Division: WATER
Bureau: WATERSHED MANAGEMENT
Issue/Topic: NONPOINT SOURCE LOCAL ASSISTANCE GRANTS FUNDING
Proposed Change: Amend s. 281.65 (4) (f) as follows:

Administer the distribution of grants and aids to governmental units for local administration and implementation of the program under this section. A grant awarded under this section may be used for technical assistance, educational and training assistance, ordinance development and administration, cost-sharing for management practices and capital improvements, plan preparation, easements or other activities determined by the department to satisfy the requirements of this section. A grant may not be used for promotional items, except for promotional items that are used for informational purposes, such as brochures or videos.

Explanatory Note: This would partially restore s. 281.65 (4) (f) to its pre 1999 Wisconsin Act 9 status. The 1999 Wisconsin Act 9 changes were evidently made to reflect the shifting of county local assistance grants funding from the Department to DATCP for priority watershed projects. However, the Department must retain the ability to make local assistance grants to other local government entities with whom the state has existing commitments. These other local governmental entities include lake districts, and, potentially, suburban areas and towns that may not meet the 281.66 (1) (e) definition of "urban". Additionally, if the Department were to get funding to administer local assistance grants for targeted runoff management (TRM) projects, the Department would need the authority to make a local assistance grant to any local governmental entity eligible for a TRM grant.

Desired Effective Date: Effective date of the budget act.
