## 8. Drainage Board Grant Program

### Explanation:

The Legislature created a drainage board grant program in the 1999-2001 biennial budget act (1999 Wis. Act 9). The Legislature created the grant program to help county drainage boards comply with major new requirements under ch. 88, Stats. (drainage law) and ch. ATCP 48, Wis. Adm. Code (drainage district rules). The Legislature created the grant program under ss. 20.115(7)(d) and 88.15, Stats., and provided an initial appropriation of \$500,000 GPR for FY 2000-01.

The Legislature established inconsistent "sunset" dates for the grant program. Under s. 20.115(7)(d), Stats., the Legislature established a "sunset" date of June 30, 2004. But under s. 88.15, Stats., the Legislature established a later "sunset" date of June 30, 2006. The department proposes to correct this inconsistency, and recommends a sunset date of June 30, 2006. The department also proposes to convert the program from an annual to a biennial appropriation.

### Statutory Changes:

SECTION \_\_\_\_ . 20.115(7)(d) of the statutes is amended to read:

20.115(7)(d) *Drainage board grants.* ~~The~~ Biennially, the amounts in the schedule for grants to drainage boards under s. 88.15. No moneys may be encumbered from this appropriation after June 30, ~~2004~~ 2006.
