**Topic:** DJC Daily Rates and Removing Alternate Care Rates from Statutes

**Current Language**

Current language §301.26(4) sets the statutory rates for juvenile in correctional facilities and in community corrections over the time period of the biennium.

**Proposed Change**

Update the statutory dates and the rates calculated for the biennium. In addition, it would remove the statutory rates for the various alternate care facilities.

**Effect of the Change**

This change will modify statutes to reflect requested juvenile and community corrections rates and removes the statutorily defined rates for alternate care facilities.

### **Rationale for the Change**

Rates reflecting the cost of care in juvenile correctional institutions and community corrections are set in statute and updated each biennium. Removing the statutorily defined rates for alternate care facilities will allow the Department to charge the counties the rate established by each facility. The Department currently charges counties the statutorily defined rate, but then must pay the alternate care facility whatever rate the individual facility charges.



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3 department, after consulting with the child welfare agency, may place the juvenile  
4 in a Type 1 secured correctional facility under the supervision of the department,
