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

Subject: Budget draft request relating to Operation Ceasefire

I am requesting statutory language be drafted for inclusion with the 2001-03 biennial budget bill.

Operation Ceasefire was created by 1999 Wisconsin Act 9 to prosecute the illegal possession and use of firearms in both state and federal courts in Milwaukee. Effective dates in Act 9 limit certain support of these efforts to the 1999-2001 biennium.

The requested draft will provide funding in the 2001-03 budget to support the two existing Milwaukee County clerk positions in the district attorney office dedicated to Operation Ceasefire. Funding will also continue at the current level to reimburse the Milwaukee board of police and fire commissioners for the Operation Ceasefire media/deterrence campaign.

Please make relevant changes to statutory language in s. 62.50 (23m) for the media campaign and s. 978.13 (1)(d) for the clerks. Language referring to computers under s. 20.475 (1)(f) may be eliminated.

Since one of your goals is to avoid the need for future amendments, I can eliminate any reference to particular years in both the media campaign and the DA clerks provisions. Section 62.50 (23m) would read, in part, "The amounts paid by the department of administration under this subsection in any fiscal year may not exceed \$60,000." Section 978.13 (1) (d) would read, in part, "The amount paid under this paragraph in any fiscal year may not exceed the amount appropriated under s. 20.475 (1) (f) less \$60,000."

Is that okay?

STATE GOVERNMENT ✓

DISTRICT ATTORNEYS ✓

Under current law, the state is responsible for funding certain operational expenses of district attorney offices. Among other things, the state must reimburse Milwaukee County for the costs of clerks who work in the Milwaukee County district attorney's office and who assist in the handling of cases involving the unlawful possession or use of firearms. The amount of reimbursement is capped at a specified amount for each fiscal year of the 1999-2001 fiscal biennium.

This bill limits the reimbursement amount to the amount of money in the appropriation from which the reimbursement is made. The bill also deletes an obsolete reference in the same appropriation to the purchase of computers to be used by prosecutors and clerks in the Milwaukee County district attorney's office on cases involving the unlawful possession or use of firearms.

LOCAL GOVERNMENT ✓

Under current law, the Milwaukee board of police and fire commissioners is required to conduct a city-wide communications media campaign to educate the public about the legal consequences of unlawful possession and use of firearms, with the goal of deterring both. Current law also requires the state to provide money to the board for that media campaign. This bill eliminates the media campaign requirement and the reimbursement for it.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

1 SECTION 1. 20.475 (1) (f) ^X of the statutes is amended to read:

10 and fringe benefit costs of 2 clerk positions providing clerical services to the
11 prosecutors in the district attorney's office handling cases involving the unlawful
12 possession or use of firearms. The state treasurer shall pay the amount authorized
13 under this paragraph to the county treasurer from the appropriation under s. 20.475
14 (1) (f) pursuant to a voucher submitted by the district attorney to the department of
15 administration. The amount paid under this paragraph may not exceed \$51,300 in
16 the 1999-2000 fiscal year and \$64,000 in the 2000-01 fiscal year the amount
17 appropriated under s. 20.475 (1) (f). [✓]


