Define Problem Precisely The 99-01 budget (Act 9) created ss 16.9651 to fund planning grants to local units of government to be used to finance the cost of planning activities related to the transportation element of a comprehensive plan. Language created in 20.505(1)(z) and inserted in 20.395(3)(ix) specifies that moneys received from the federal government and transferred from the transportation fund to DOA for this purpose should come from 20.395(3)(ix). Federal planning funds of this nature are administered by the Division of Transportation Investment Management and are generally appropriated in the transportation fund under 20.395(4)(ax) rather than under 20.395(3)(ix). In order to align the statutory language with the correct division and appropriation, we request to have language modified to specify that federal funding transferred to DOA from DOT for this purpose is transferred from 20.395(4)(ax).			
Description of Proposed Change Amend s.20.395(3)(ix) to remove language added in Act 9; amend 20.505(1)(z) to delete 20.395(3)(ix) and insert 20.395(4)(ax). This would align the federal planning funding to be used for this purpose with the correct division and appropriation.			
Justification for Change The Division of Transportation Investment Management administers federal planning funds under 20.395(4)(ax). This would not modify the intent of 16.9651 and would essentially be a technical correction to language in Act 9 to conform to department appropriation structure.			
Describe any legislative history and related statutory language The 99-01 budget created this program and language in the appropriations as noted above.
