Currently, under the veterans' retraining grant program, DVA awards employment retraining grants of up to \$3,000 to eligible veterans who are unemployed, underemployed, or who have received a notice of termination of employment. As a condition of eligibility for a retraining grant, a veteran must be enrolled in a proprietary school that is approved by the educational approval board, other than a proprietary school that offers 4-year degrees or 4-year programs, enrolled in a technical college training course, or be engaged in a structured on-the-job training program. (be)

This bill permits DVA to pay a retraining grant to a veteran's employer, on behalf of the veteran, if the veteran is engaged in a structured on-the-job training program and is otherwise eligible for the retraining grant program.

For further information see the *state* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

2 SECTION 1. 45.397 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

1 45.397 (1) GRANT AMOUNT AND APPLICATION. The department may grant a
2 veteran not more than \$3,000 for retraining to enable the veteran to obtain gainful
3 employment. The department shall determine the amount of the grant based on the
4 veteran's financial need. A veteran may apply for a grant to the county veterans'
5 service officer of the county in which the veteran is living. The department may, on
6 behalf of a veteran who is engaged in a structured on-the-job training program and
7 who meets the requirements under sub. (2), pay a retraining grant under this
8 subsection to the veteran's employer.
