## 2001-2003 Statutory Language Proposals

Division: AIR & WASTE; WATER

Bureau: REMEDIATION AND REDEVELOPMENT; WATERSHED  
MANAGEMENT

Issue/Topic: ENVIRONMENTAL REPAIR AND GREAT LAKES BONDING

Proposed Change: The Department is proposing to increase environmental repair bonding authority by \$15,000,000 and great lakes remedial action bonding authority by \$5,000,000 over current levels. Accordingly, s. 20.866 (2) (tg) must be amended:

(tg) *Natural resources; environmental repair.* From the capital improvement fund, a sum sufficient for the department of natural resources to fund investigations and remedial action under s 292.11 (7) (a) or 292.31 and remedial action under s. 281.83 and for payment of this state's share of environmental repair that is funded under 42 USC 6991 to 6991i or 42 USC 9601 to 9675. The state may contract public debt in an amount not to exceed ~~\$43,000,000~~ \$63,000,000 for this purpose. Of this amount, ~~\$5,000,000~~ \$10,000,000 is allocated for remedial action under s. 281.83.

Explanatory Note: The Department has requested \$15,000,000 in general obligation bonding to fund remedial actions at contamination sites throughout the state. In addition to federal Superfund sites, potential clean-up sites include landfills, dry cleaning facilities, industrial petroleum sites where there is no viable responsible party, and emergency environmental clean-up actions.

Additionally, the Department has requested an additional \$5,000,000 in general obligation bonding authority to assist in the cleanup of Great Lakes areas of concern.

Desired Effective Date: The effective date of the budget.

**HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCES AND ENVIRONMENTAL CLEANUP**

Current law authorizes the issuance of general obligation bonds to pay for actions taken to clean up the environment under specified programs administered by DNR. This bill increases the general obligation bonding authority for these clean-up programs by \$20,000,000. Of this amount, \$5,000,000 is allocated for cleanups in or adjacent to the Great Lakes or their tributaries.

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*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

2 SECTION 1. 20.866 (2) (tg) of the statutes is amended to read:  
3 20.866 (2) (tg) *Natural resources; environmental repair.* From the capital  
4 improvement fund, a sum sufficient for the department of natural resources to fund

Thus the language will be as follow: "...not to exceed \$48,000,000 for this purpose. Of this amount, \$7,000,000 is allocated for remedial action under s. 281.83."
