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

The intent of this request is to extend the current Warren Knowles-Gaylord Nelson Stewardship Program prohibition on the expenditure of program funds for the acquisition or development of land acquired by condemnation [s. 23.0915(1m)(b)], to the Warren Knowles-Gaylord Nelson Stewardship 2000 Program [s. 23.0917].

Although other prohibitions on the use of Stewardship Program funds were included in the new Stewardship 2000 Program, the prohibition relating to the expenditure of funds for projects that affect property acquired by local units of government through condemnation was not. This request would make the Stewardship 2000 Program subject to this prohibition.
