DOA CONSOLIDATION OF APPROPRIATIONS

Introduction: Simplification of Government

Since the 1987-89 biennial budget, the appropriation structure of the Department of Administration had increased from 60 appropriations to 119. This doubling of the number of appropriations has added complexity to the financial structure used to administer department programs. Oftentimes the complexity is repetitious because other elements of the state's structure duplicate the same or similar purpose.

The state's relatively new Wismart financial system permits bountiful identification and collection of data for policy makers that previously was primarily gathered in the old appropriation structure under the former accounting system. Now additional choices are available. In an era when simpler solutions and ways of doing business are sought to streamline government processes, especially administrative processes, the Department would like to simplify the appropriation structure of its programs. This combined with selected position reductions will permit the department to provide more cost-effective service.

The Governor's biennial instructions for 2001-03 include Major Budget Policies stress "Increasing Productivity/Adding Value for State Taxpayers." It is noted that decision items which remove barriers to employe and agency productivity will be given a high priority. Specifically under this directive agencies are encouraged to consider consolidating similar appropriations.

The Department has made a thorough review of its appropriation structure and believes a significant reduction in the complexity of the structure can be obtained without sacrificing any of the financial management or reporting needs of the state. The proposed consolidations and elimination are described below and grouped by several categories. The department also proposes a limited renumbering of programs and appropriations to eliminate a technical problem of denominated double-digit programs (i.e. programs 10 and 11) in the B system.

Consolidate Gifts and Grants Appropriations

Currently the Department has ten programs, 1,2,3,4,5,6,7,8,10, and 11. Programs 1, 3,4,6 and 7 have their own program revenue gifts and grant appropriations with similar language. For programs without a specific gifts and grants appropriation the appropriation in program 1 is used.

All the existing gifts and grants appropriations are Program Revenue continuing appropriations.

Each gift the department receives is tracked separately for accountability and the department does this by assigning a particular Activity Code to each gift. Any one appropriation is likely to have many Activity Codes to track gifts. Whether the codes are in one appropriation or many appropriations makes no difference to the distinct tracking of specific gifts. Having many appropriations exist does however add complexity to financial activity and reporting. Each appropriation requires separate allotment tracking, cash monitoring reports, closing and reconciliation documents. This would consolidate appropriations 20.505(3)(g), 20.505(4)(gm), 20.505(7)(g) into 20.505(1)(j) for a reduction of four appropriations. The remaining appropriation 20.505(1)(j) would be re-titled "Gifts, donations and grants" to be used department-wide. Existing statutory reporting requirements on gifts and grants under 20.907(1m) would remain.

DRAFTING: Delete 20.505(3)(g) Gifts and Grants, 20.505(4)(gm) Gifts and Grants, 20.505(7)(g) Gifts and Grants. Retain 20.505(1)(j) as at present but retitle 20.505(1)(j) "Gifts, donations, and grants."

Consolidate Several Program Fees Appropriations

Currently the Department has two similar programs, Program 3 Committees and Interstate Bodies and Program 4 Attached Divisions, Boards, Councils and Commissions, both of which are used for attachments to the department. Many of these attached programs whether in Program 3 or Program 4 do not charge fees but a few do for selected services like conferences or sale of items. Both 20.505(3)(h) and 20.505(4)(h) are Program Revenue annual appropriations with set dollar amounts in the schedule. The department uses specific codes to track revenues and fees for each activity by an attachment. This would eliminate one appropriation, 20.505(3)(h), by consolidating all attachment program revenue services in the program 4 appropriation.

DRAFTING: Delete 20.505(3)(h) Program Fees and add language amending 20.505(4)(h) to encompass "special and executive committee" in the existing list for (4)(h) in the two places where lists occur.

Combining Multiple Federal Appropriations

For a number of DOA programs, for example in Housing, the federal government will award funds for a housing program purpose and at the time of the federal award to the state the recipients within the state are unknown. After the state application and screening process, depending on whether the recipient is a local government or a non-profit

organization the dollars once awarded must go to a grants-local assistance appropriation or a grants-organization appropriation. At present when grants are awarded allotments are needed to move authority between appropriations.

All federal grants require separate tracking for each grant and an identifier is established for each in the grants module of Wismart. Reporting is based on grant identifier tracking rather than appropriation structure. The State Controller's Office recently agreed to combine lines 6 for local assistance and 8 for aids to organizations in the Wismart system recognizing that the allotment process between types of recipient is often made arbitrarily until grants awards are defined.

As the state has moved to using private non-profits to deliver local assistance efforts for some programs "local assistance" no longer even means local government. Actual disbursements however do show type of recipient, i.e. a local government versus an organization, in the object coding. Appropriation structure is no longer the best tool for a priori defining or estimating such disbursements. In housing programs the legislature has even extended eligibility to for profit organizations.

All federal and statutory program requirements would remain for programs but the overlay of conflicting appropriations would be reduced. A number of programs transferred to the department or newly initiated over the years have resulted in parallel federal appropriations that can be consolidated though all distinct recording of grants for purposes made will be maintained. This will also permit several parallel federal appropriations for state operations or administration to be consolidated as well. The department is not proposing consolidating federal appropriations across programs.

For Program 1 appropriation 20.505(1)(mb) would be renamed Federal grants/contracts for all grants. Then 20.505(1)(ma), 20.505(1)(mc), and 20.505(1)(n) would be repealed. For Program 6 appropriation 20.505(6)(m) would be used for all state operations/administration and 20.505(6)(o) and 20.505(6)(pc) would be repealed. For Program 6 all grant assistance regardless of recipient would be in 20.505(6)(p), then 20.505(6)(pa), and 20.505(6)(pb) would be repealed. For Housing programs 20.505(7)(o) would be used regardless of recipient and 20.505(7)(n) would be repealed. A reduction of eight appropriations would result.

DRAFTING: Delete 20.505(1)(ma) Federal grants and contracts, 20.505(1)(mc) Coastal zone management, and 20.505(1)(n) Federal aid: local assistance. Amend 20.505(1)(mb) to read "Federal grants and contracts. All moneys received from the federal government as

authorized by the governor under s. 16.54 to carry out the purposes for which made. (Note to the drafter the reason 20.505(1)(mb) is suggested for redrafting to a more generic use rather than use (1)(ma) is because the level of present activity is high in (1)(mb) and many more grants will not have to be moved versus the other way around.

DRAFTING: Repeal 20.505(6)(o) Federal aid, criminal justice improvement projects, state operations and 20.505(6)(pc) Federal aid, anti-drug enforcement program, state operations. Amend 20.505(6)(m) to read "Federal aid, justice assistance, state operations, All moneys received from the federal government for state agency operations for justice assistance as authorized by the governor under 16.54 to carry out the purposes for which received."

DRAFTING: Repeal 20.505(6)(pa) Federal aid, criminal justice improvement projects, aid to organizations, and 20.505(6)(pb) Federal aid, anti-drug enforcement program, aids and local assistance. Amend 20.505(6)(p) to read "Federal aid, local assistance and aids. All moneys received from the federal government for project grants to improve the administration of criminal justice as authorized by the governor under s.16.54.

DRAFTING: Repeal 20.505(7)(n). Amend 20.505(7)(o) to read "Federal aid, local assistance and aids. All moneys received from the federal government as authorized by the governor under s. 16.54 related to housing assistance.

Justice Information Support

The Department's support for Justice Information technology is now spread across three different Program Revenue Appropriations, each an annual appropriation with amounts in the schedule. The appropriations are distinguished by the revenue source but all serve the same combined purpose of Justice Information Support. The appropriations support the provision of computer technology to district attorneys, the development of software for the district attorneys systems, and connections to other justice technology systems. Revenues can be adequately tracked by distinguishing revenue codes in the revenue reports and do not require separate appropriations. Many appropriations now have multiple revenues that are so distinguished. Additionally, there is a separate unused numeric within 20.505(1)(ja) that can be deleted. Combining all the Justice Information Support appropriations would eliminate two alpha and three numeric appropriations. It is proposed 20.505(1)(ja) and 20.505(1)(kp) be eliminated and all revenues and expenses tracked in 20.505(1)(kq).

DRAFTING: Repeal 20.505(1)(ja) and 20.505(1)(kp). Amend 20.505(1)(kq) to read "Justice information systems. The amounts in the schedule for the development, operation and maintenance of automated justice information systems under s. 16.971(9). Two ninths of the moneys received under 814.635(1) shall be credited to this appropriation. All moneys transferred from the appropriation under 20.505(6)(o) and 20.505(6)(j) 12 shall be credited to this appropriation.

Combining Several GPR Appropriations

Within 20.505(1)(a) there are two numeric administrative appropriations, one large appropriation which is the general department administration appropriation for state ops and a very much smaller one for the state prosecutor's office, which is also a state operations function. Originally the prosecutor's office had a different SEG funding but more recently was converted to GPR. It is proposed to combine the two numerics within the alpha. Likewise there is a separate GPR appropriation for the one administrative person who supports the Claims Board. The Department proposes 20.505(4)(c) be combined into 20.505(1)(a).

DRAFTING: Repeal 20.505(4)(c).

In Program 7 for Housing there are four parallel GPR assistance programs that could be combined into two appropriations. Appropriations 20.505(7)(b) and 20.505(7)(d) serve to support housing programs and organizations based on competitive awards. Separate programs could still be conducted within the one appropriation and 20.505(7)(d) repealed. When homeless and transitional programs were moved into the Department an older appropriation structure that related to a GPR match for a now no longer existing federal program resulted in two appropriations. The Department proposes 20.505(7)(fm) could be used for all homeless and transitional programs and 20.505(7)(dm) repealed.

DRAFTING: Repeal 20.505(7)(d). Amend 20.505(7)(b) to read "Housing grants and loans to housing organizations. Biennially the amounts in the schedule for grants and loans under s. 16.33 and s. 16.336.

DRAFTING: Repeal 20.505(7)(dm). Amend 20.505(7)(fm) to read "Shelter for homeless and transitional housing grants. The amounts in the schedule for transitional housing grants under 16.339 and for grants to agencies and shelter facilities for homeless individuals and families as provided under 16.352.

Notwithstanding ss. 20.001(3)(a) and 20.002(1), the department may transfer funds between fiscal years under this paragraph. All funds allocated but not encumbered by December 31 of each year lapse to the general fund on the next January 1 unless transferred to the next calendar year by the joint committee on finance.

Combining Several PR Appropriations with Similar Program Functions

The Office of Justice Assistance has two PR grant appropriations one directed to locals and the other to state agencies. Separate appropriations 20.505(6)(kq) and 20.505(6)(ks) are proposed for combination.

DRAFTING: Repeal 20.505(6)(ks). Amend 20.505(6)(kq) to read "County and tribal law enforcement services. The amounts in the schedule to provide grants to counties under 16.964(7) and for tribal law enforcement under 16.964(6). All moneys transferred from the appropriation account under s. 20.505(8)(hm) 15 shall be credited to this appropriation."

In Housing three similar PR appropriations are proposed for combination 20.505(7)(k), 20.505(7)(kg), and 20.505(7)(km). In like manner two continuing PR appropriations with different revenue sources but similar expenditure purposes for homeless funding should be combined. One is an active appropriation and the other with almost no activity. Revenue codes can distinguish the source of funds. It is proposed to rename 20.505(7)(h) for both programs and repeal 20.505(7)(gm)

DRAFTING: Repeal 20.505(7)(k) and 20.505(7)(km). Amend 20.505(7)(kg) to read "Housing program services. All moneys received for housing program services from state agencies or from the sale of materials or services or for weatherization programs under 16.54 for the purpose received

DRAFTING: Repeal 20.505(7)(gm). Amend 20.505(h) to read "Funding for homeless, All moneys received from interest on real estate trust accounts under s.452.13 for grants under 16.531 and all moneys received under s. 704(5)(a)2. for grants to agencies and shelter facilities for homeless individuals and families under s.16.352(2)(a) and (b).

Repealed Appropriations

The Chapter 20 schedule has a number of appropriations that are or will be repealed. The appropriation for census education 20.505(1)(e) should be repealed as its activities are completed. The appropriation for

National Community Services Wisconsin promise challenge grants 20.505(4)(fm) should be repealed as the program is no longer active. In the same vein 20.505(1)(s) Wisconsin sesquicentennial commission; payment of obligations can be repealed. The published schedule also shows 20.505(5)(h) for Lease payments for educational broadcasting facilities and 20.505(5)(i) Emergency weather warning system operation both of which should have been eliminated except for a technical oversight.

DRAFTING: Repeal 20.505(1)(e) Census education assistance and 20.505(4)(fm) National community service board; Wisconsin promise challenge grants and 20.505(1)(s) Wisconsin sesquicentennial commission; payment of obligations.

Eliminate Program 3 and renumber Programs 10 and 11

The Department has two similar areas in Program 3 Committees and Interstate Bodies and in Program 4 Attached Divisions, Boards, Council, and Commissions for organizations that are attached to the Department for administrative purposes. Program 3 has only six appropriations. Above it has been proposed to combine all gifts and grants and repeal 20.505(3)(g) and likewise to combine 20.505(3)(h) program fees with 20.505(4)(h). By renumbering remaining appropriations into Program 4 then Program 3 can be eliminated or reused. The reuse is an issue because the last budget established programs 10 and 11 for the Department but these double-digit programs do not fit into budget systems. By freeing up program 3 for this purpose Chapter 20 can be better organized with other systems.

DRAFTING: Renumber the remaining appropriations in program 3 to program 4 and then renumber appropriations in programs 10 and 11 to the now freed up program 3.

Conclusion

The Department believes this modest proposal should receive swift consideration as a measure to simplify government procedures. As the department has been asked to assume additional responsibilities over the last decade complexity has resulted, often needlessly. The Department proposes to continue to deliver programs as directed by the Governor and the Legislature but using more up-to-date tools of the Wismart system in conjunction with a slimmed down appropriation structure. The Department believes the proposal is consistent with Budget Policy directives. As positions reductions now proposed by the Department including several administrative positions are considered, the Department believes a simplified administrative structure is required to continue an emphasis on program staff to deliver services in a cost effective manner.

Under current law, appropriations to DOA are grouped into 11 general categories, each of which consists of appropriations that are related by purpose. For example, one category consists of appropriations for DOA's attached divisions, boards, councils, and commissions and another category consists of appropriations for DOA's housing assistance program. Some appropriations across categories are duplicative and a number of appropriations within individual categories have the same or similar funding sources and similar purposes. The bill consolidates duplicative or similar appropriations into single, combined appropriations, eliminates those appropriations that are combined into another, and moves certain appropriations into different categories, thereby reducing the overall number of DOA's appropriation accounts and the overall number of categories into which they are grouped.

Under current law, appropriations to DOA are grouped into 11 general categories, each of which consists of appropriations that are related by purpose. For example, one category consists of appropriations for DOA's attached divisions, boards, councils, and commissions and another category consists of appropriations for DOA's housing assistance program. Some appropriations across categories are duplicative and a number of appropriations within individual categories have the same or similar funding sources and similar purposes. The bill consolidates duplicative or similar appropriations into single, combined appropriations, eliminates those appropriations that are combined into another, and moves certain appropriations into different categories, thereby reducing the overall number of DOA's appropriation accounts and the overall number of categories into which they are grouped.



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

Currently, program revenue is appropriated to DOA in separate appropriations for: 1) transportation services; 2) printing, mail distribution, and records services; and 3) information technology processing and certain telecommunications services. The revenue is derived from moneys received from other state agencies. The appropriations for transportation, printing, document sales, mail distribution, and records services are limited to specified amounts and the appropriation for information technology processing and telecommunications services is limited only by the revenue received. This bill repeals the appropriation for printing, mail distribution, and records services and consolidates that appropriation with the other appropriations so that mail transportation, document sales, and records services are funded from the transportation services appropriation, and mail processing and printing services are funded from the information technology processing and telecommunications services appropriation.

~~Under the consolidations,~~ revenue collected for one purpose may be used by DOA for a different purpose within the same appropriation account, subject to budgetary intent of the governor, JCF, and legislature, as specified in various budgetary documents.
