SUBJECT: Distribution of School Library Aid-Biennial Budget Amendment

I am writing to ask for your consideration of the inclusion of a statutory language request related to the distribution of school library aid in the Governor's 2001-03 biennial budget.

Current law presents a difficulty to the department and to school districts in the distribution of school library aid from the Common School Fund. Specifically, 43.70 (3), Wis. Stats., requires the department to notify school district administrators in January of the amount of school library aid that they are expected to receive. The actual payment of school library aid is not made until sometime before June 30. Therefore, the department is dependent on an estimate made by the Board of Commissioners of Public Lands to inform districts of future payments. It would be more fiscally prudent to base aid payments on the actual amount available in the Common School Fund sent to the department annually on April 15.

The department also requests that current law be modified to require it to pay school library aids ~~on~~ ~~May 1~~ based on the actual amount transferred to it from the Board of Commissioners of Public Lands on April 15. It is believed that this change would address concerns recently raised by DOA and LAB auditors regarding this appropriation. In addition, school districts would be more accurately informed of the revenues they can expect to receive and would be better able to plan accordingly. The department would also distribute funds based on a true balance, rather than on an estimate that may not be accurate six months later.
