Under current law, the department of commerce may award a grant of up to \$10,000 to a business with 25 or fewer employees, or with no more than \$2,500,000 in gross annual income in the preceding year, for the purpose of providing skills training or other education related to the needs of the business to current or prospective employees of the business. The statutes do not specify the appropriation out of which the grants are to be paid. The bill provides that the grants are to be paid out of an appropriation that is funded with Indian gaming revenue. ✓
